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HIV Specialty care is important for people living with HIV/AIDS

Everyone living with HIV/AIDS in the Philadelphia area can receive quality health care from an HIV Specialist, **regardless of their ability to pay.**

HIV Specialists are medical providers who:

- See many people living with HIV/AIDS (at least 20 in the last 2 years)
- Keep updated on HIV treatment advances

Regular dental care is important for people living with HIV/AIDS

Regular dental check-ups are recommended for everyone every 6 months. This is especially important for people living with HIV/AIDS, because:

- Medications that fight HIV can have side effects that create changes in the mouth.
- Symptoms of opportunistic infections (OIs) can appear in the mouth before they appear anywhere else in the body.
