Reasons to have an AEM Community Workshop:

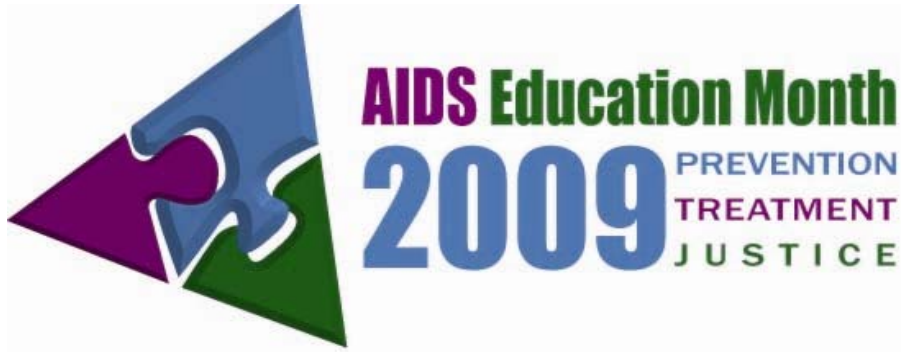
- New estimates cite that 30,000 people in the city of Philadelphia are infected with HIV.
