PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED

ANGER MANAGEMENT 10 weeks

THURSDAY 1p – 3p

Participants identify stressors, begin to take necessary steps to control their anger and handle tense situations in a constructive manner.

TRANSFORMATION YOGA PROJECT

THURSDAY 3p – 4p

A trauma sensitive approach to yoga. Designed for individuals who have been impacted by mass incarceration.

FINANCIAL LITERACY 7 weeks

TUESDAY 1:30p – 3p

Empowers individuals to take charge of their financial lives.
