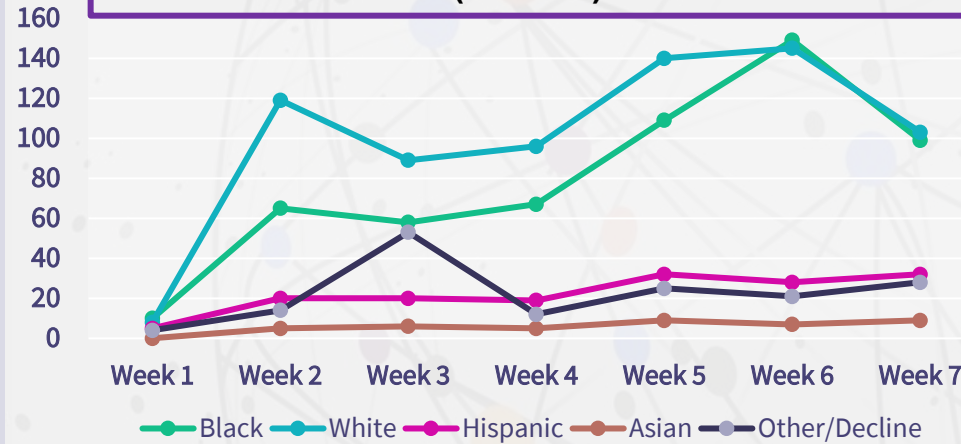
Background

- First case of SARS-coV-2 [COVID-19] identified in Philadelphia on March 10th, 2020 with 124,132 cases diagnosed to date in Philadelphia County (1,020,300 cases in PA)
- First COVID-19 vaccine doses arrived in Philadelphia on December 14th, 2020 destined for hospital and emergency medical staff (Pfizer)
- FIGHT began vaccinating staff on December 30th, 2020

Philadelphia FIGHT Vaccination Program

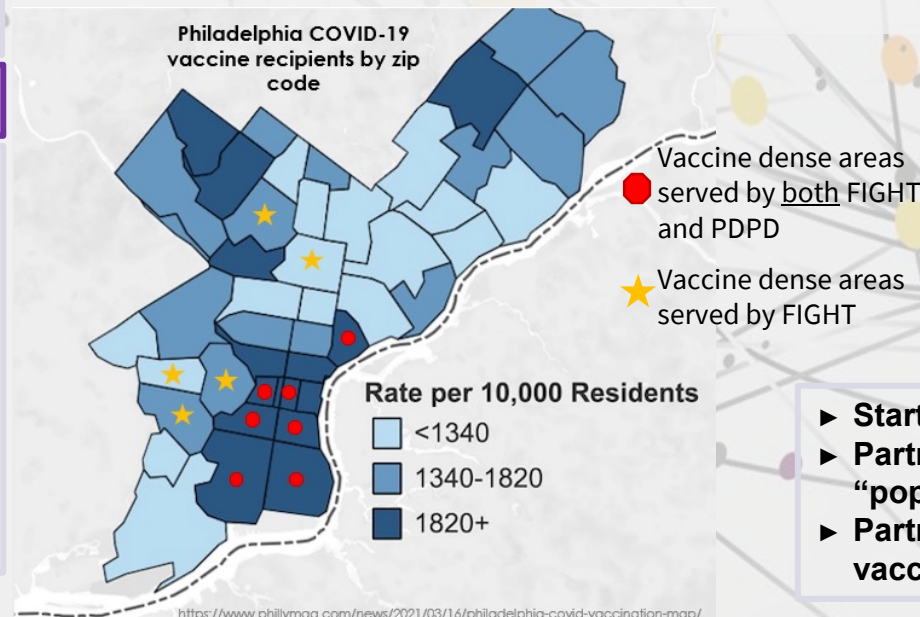
- Patient/community vaccination efforts began February 9th, 2021 (Moderna)
- Community interest collected via REDCap survey
- Direct patient referrals through EMR
- Currently able to serve Philadelphia Tier 1A and 1B (HIV made Tier 1B eligible on March 10th, 2021)
- 1000th shot administered on March 9th, 2021
