PrEP Week 24 Symposium

HIV Prevention in 2024: Responding to a Changing Landscape



Friday, September 20

1:00–5:30pm (registration opens at 12:30pm)

Location: Science History Institute (315 Chestnut St)

This event is ideal for providers, allied health professionals, and students. A networking happy hour will follow the educational programming of this event!

Given ongoing political pressures to the provision of gender-affirming care and harm reduction services, we're ready to discuss barriers, facilitators, and catalysts in infectious disease prevention and the creative solutions we need to support our clients and communities. How will we respond to existing PrEP inequities and disproportionate burdens of HIV on marginalized populations? How do we navigate the landscape of defunding and threats to delivery of evidence-based care?

This symposium will include three (3) educational sessions:

- Presentation on stigma and language in infectious disease prevention for PWID led by Wei-Teng Yang, MD (Penn Medicine)
- Presentation on PrEP service models, their impact on PrEP gender equity, and chemsex harm reduction led by Jona Tanguay, PA-C (Whitman-Walker Health)
- Panel of local and regional experts (providers, researchers, and community health workers) on the changing HIV prevention landscape with content such as: funding limitations to harm reduction services in Philly; ongoing anti-transgender legislation and violence; translating PrEP 'awareness' to uptake in marginalized populations; and potential future tools for prevention such as new injectable PrEP medications.
